Aug 17, 2009	Chapter 8, C. "Special Orders", page 148	<b>Added to "Special Orders":</b> "Each year, the Director of Cadet Activities publishes a list of College-approved Cadet Activities and Religious Groups, and the Health and PE Department Head publishes a list of approved Club Sports. Each of these activities and Club Sports has its own rules for membership or participation but they must follow the rules and regulations as defined in Chapter 4 of the White Book "Cadet Organizations, Club Sports, and Religious Activities", and a cadet must be a member in good standing to be eligible to participate in these leaves. When individual students or groups of students travel to participate in an activity related to confirmed membership in an approved Student Activity, Religious Group, or Club Sport, they may be granted Representational Leave. <b>Eligible cadets are authorized one Representational Leave each semester.</b> Cadets on an approved Representational Leave wear an authorized Citadel Cadet uniform as specified on the order".
Aug 17, 2009	Chapter 8, G. "Privileges", "Telephones/Cell Phones " Page 161	<b>Added to "Telephones/Cell Phones":</b> At the discretion of the Commander and/or Commandant's Department, and when required in the performance of official duties, Master Sergeants and above may wear an electronic device at the hip on the belt, belt loops, or waistband of the Duty uniform . Only one electronic device may be worn; it may be either a pager or a cell phone. The body of the device may not exceed 4x2x1 inches, and the device and carrying case must be black; no other colors are authorized. Other types of electronic devices are not authorized for wear on the uniform. If the commander issues and requires the use of other electronic devices in the performance of duties, the cadet will carry them in the hand, pocket, briefcase, purse, bag, or in some other carrying container.
