The Minutes of October 16, 2008 were approved unanimously.

New Business

Proposed Changes for the MAT – Physical Education Program

- Dr. Templeton explained that in order for the MAT – Physical Education Program to remain in line with the newly revised NASPE Accreditation Standards, students will need to take all four content field approved elective courses rather than three. To address this without increasing the total number of credit hours required to complete the program, Dr. Templeton proposed that HESS 526-Physical Education

Curriculum and HESS 524-Historical and Philosophical Foundations/Principles of Physical Education will be combined and renamed HESS 535-History, Philosophy, and Curriculum of Physical Education. (course number was given by the Registrar). This change will most likely take affect Fall 2009

- In addition to combining the two courses, Dr. Templeton proposed that a new course entitled Advanced Measurement and Evaluation in Physical Education (HESS 561) be added as a new course beginning fall 2009. The rationale was that students in the program lacked knowledge regarding physical education assessment. Some students will need to complete course substitution forms and update their program of study to reflect the new courses
