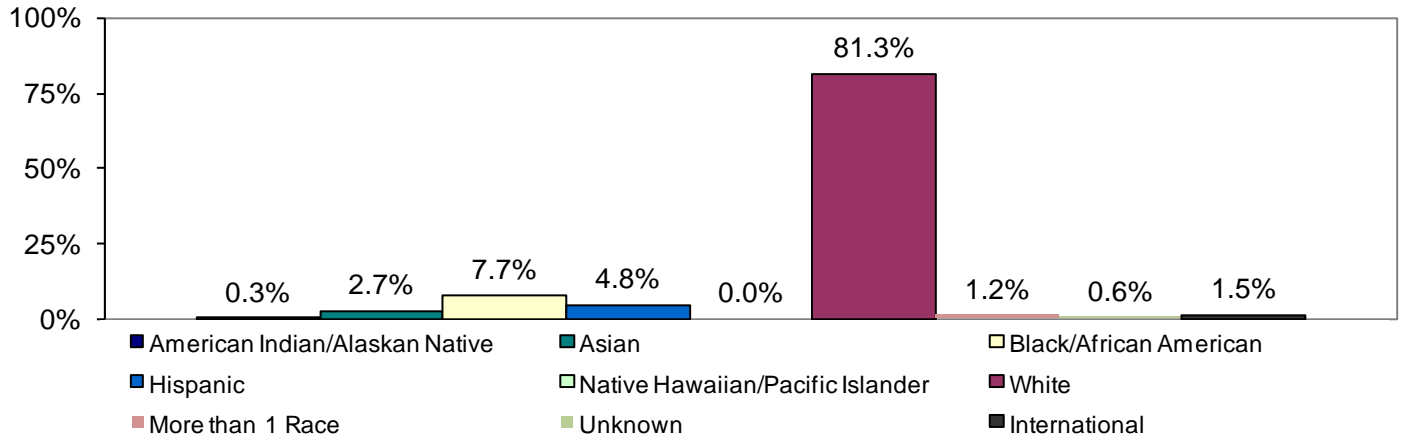

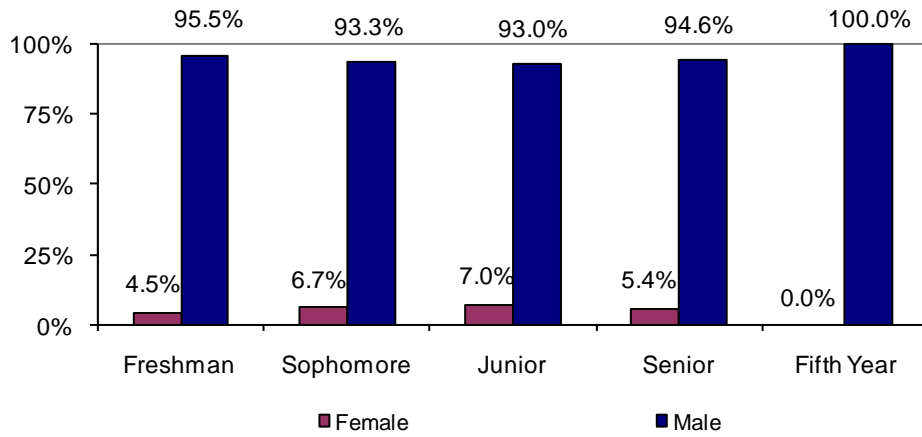

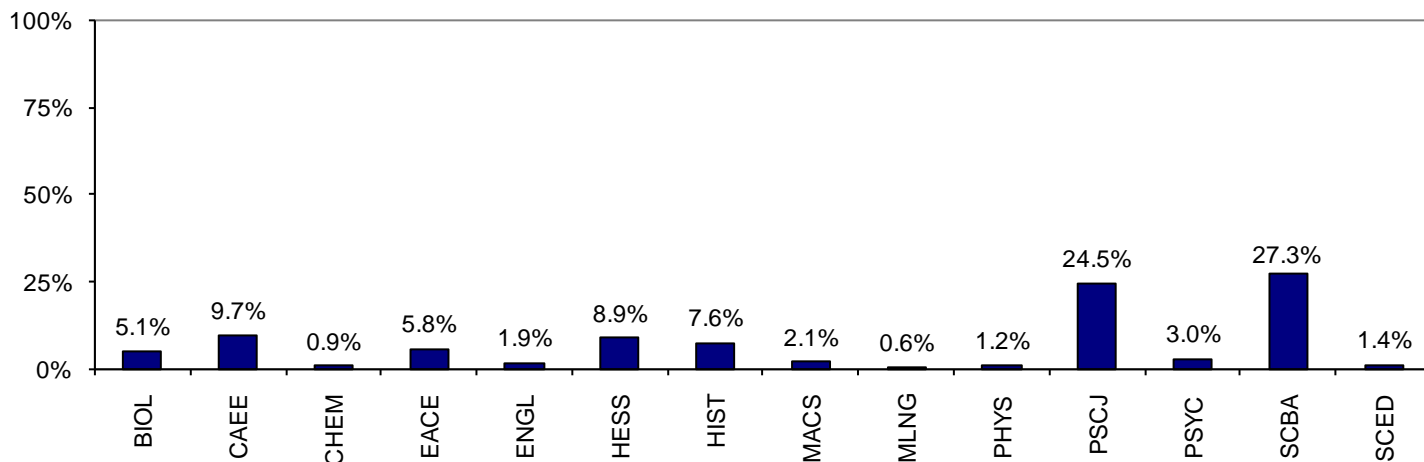

**Percent of SCCC**



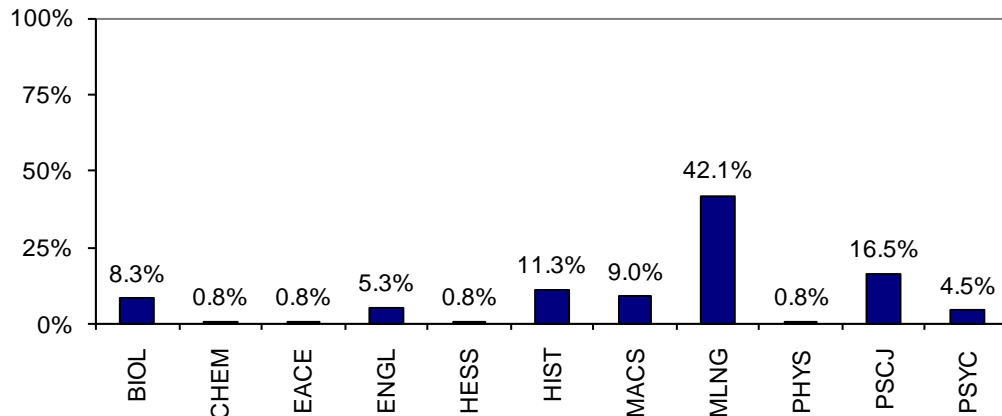

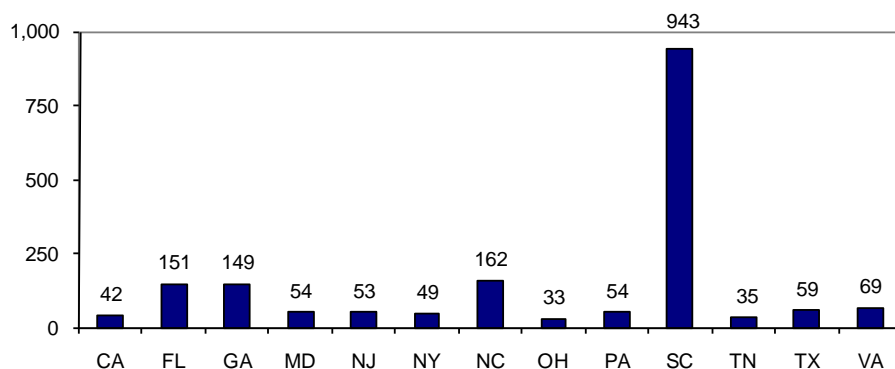

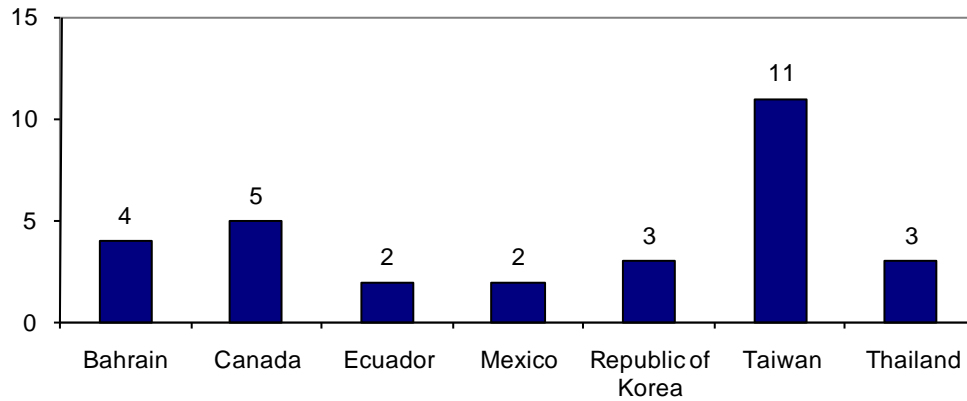

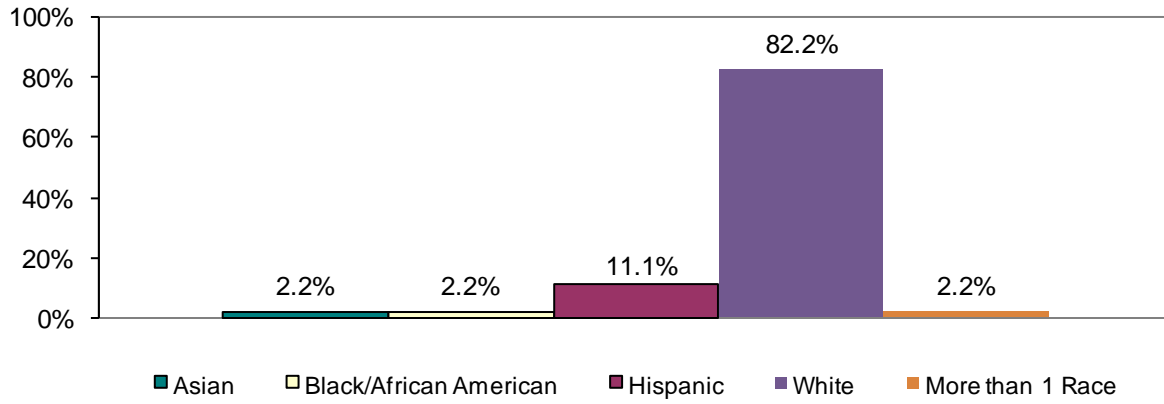

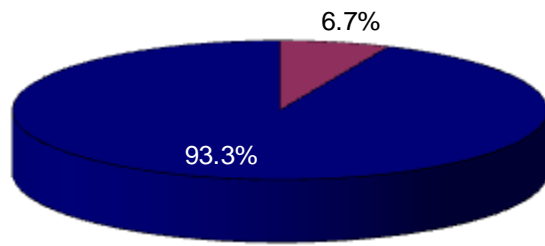

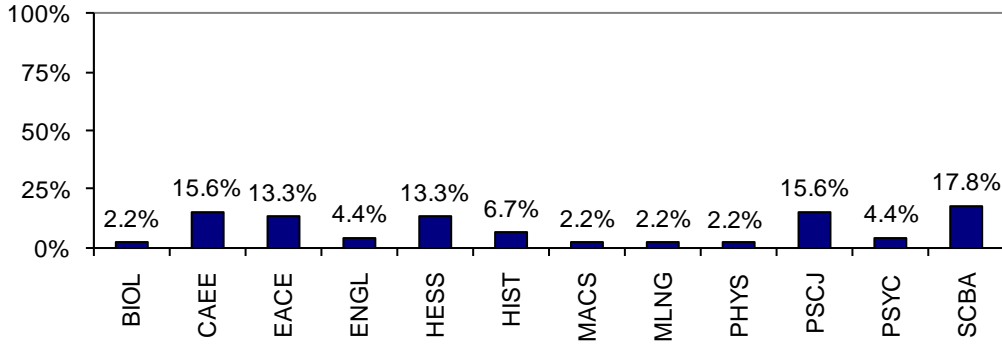

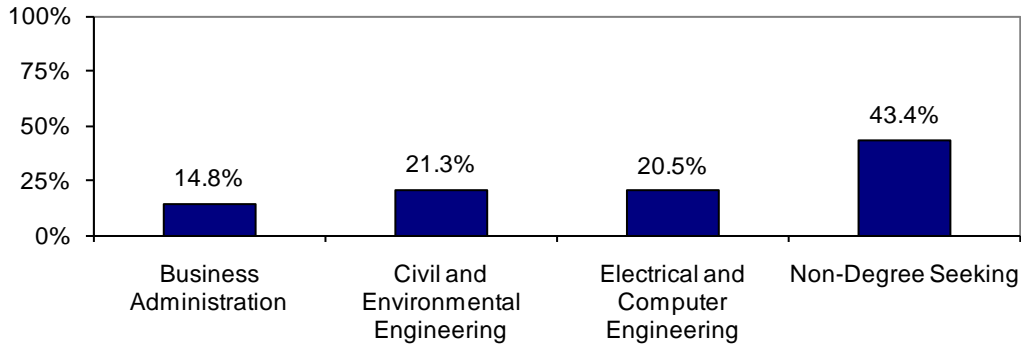

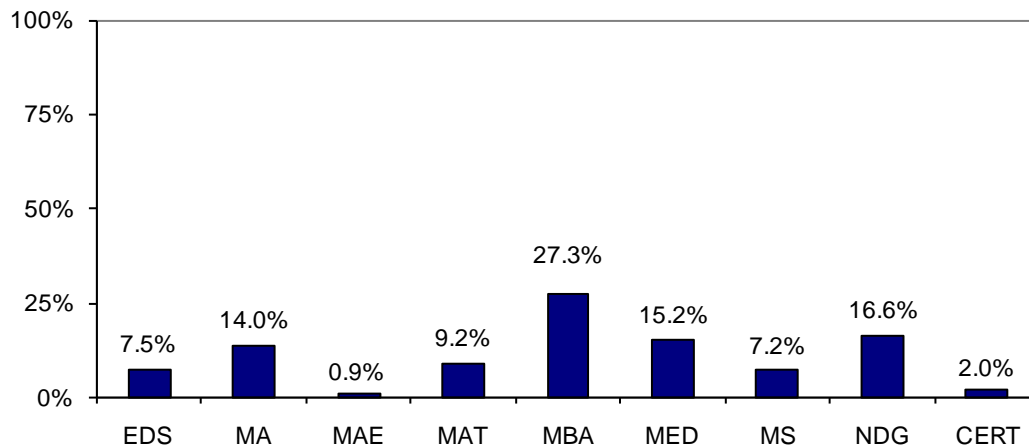

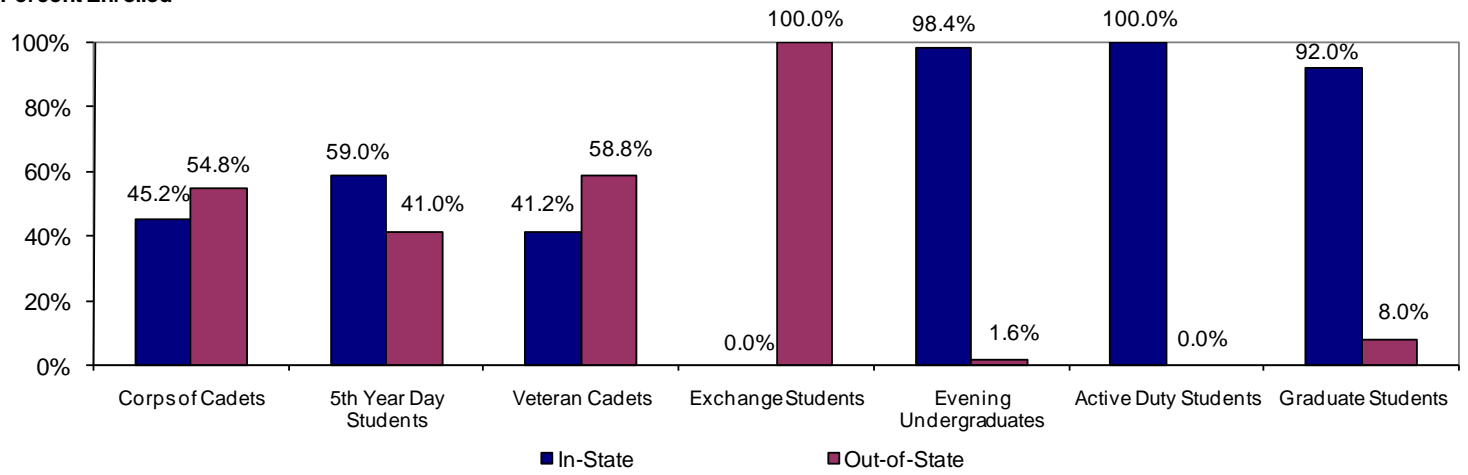

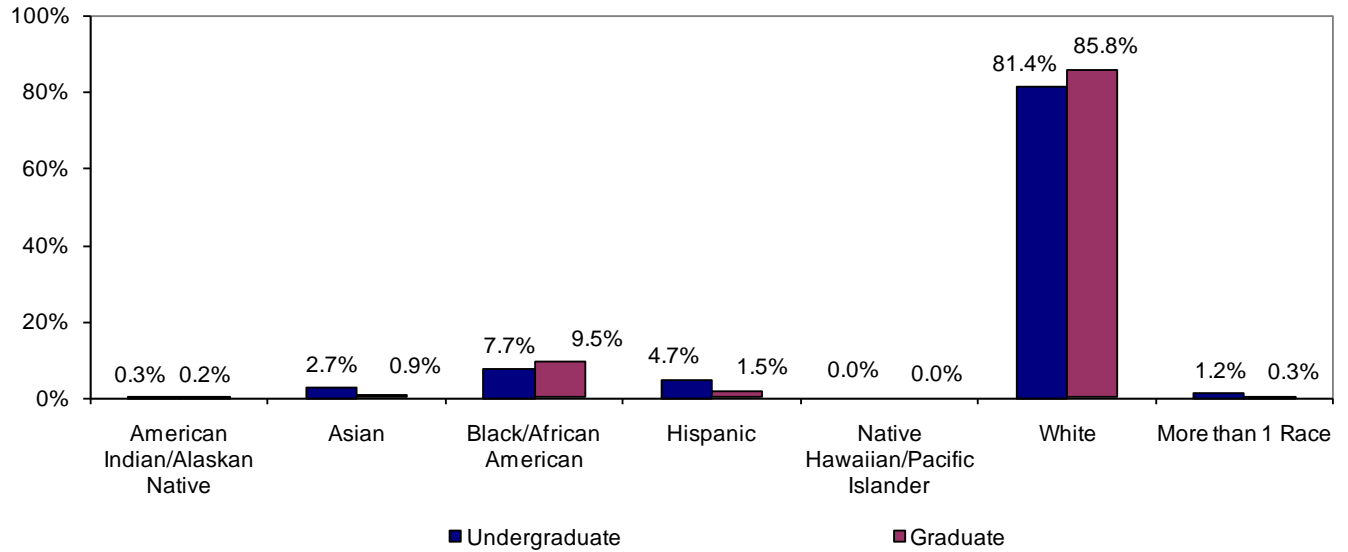

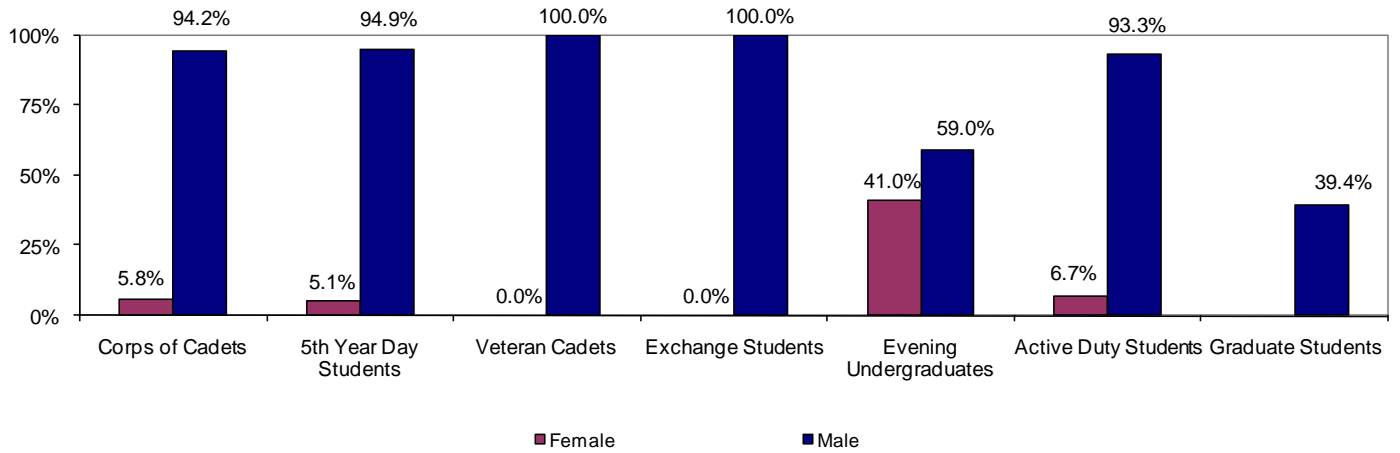
