



PASS/FAIL OPTION FORM

1. A student must be a junior or senior with a cumulative grade point ratio of 2.000 or higher.
 2. No more than one course per term can be taken on a pass-fail basis.
 3. No more than four pass-fail courses can be applied toward graduation.
 4. Only general electives can be taken on a pass-fail basis.
 5. A student may not change his decision to take the course on the pass-fail basis or for a letter grade after the first two weeks of the term.
 6. Courses completed under the pass-fail option carry graduation credit but no quality points and are not included in GPR computations.
 7. Grades "A", "B", "C" translate as an "S" (meaning "Satisfactory, Pass-for credit").
 8. Grades of "D" or "F" are translated as "U" (meaning "Unsatisfactory, Fail-no credit").
