- All media acceptable. Entries must be submitted as a highresolution digital image, on a stretched canvas, or bound on foam-core. Design should not exceed 30 x 30 inches. Preferred size is 20 x 30.
- Judging will take place in mid-May. The winning artist will be notified by August 1. The design will be unveiled at the Sept. 2, 2017, home football game in Johnson Hagood Stadium.
- The winning entry will be printed on t-shirts, banners, posters, and the 2017 Citadel magazine.
- Submitting artists must be U.S. citizens.
- Winner will receive a \$1000 cash prize. Prize is subject to tax.
