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**STEP 5 Assessments**

Parts A and B require an assessment of current knowledge and offer exams to determine placement. All of these assessments/exams are offered online through CitLearn, The Citadel's learning management software. **Part A: Foreign Language Requirement and Placement Exam**

The Citadel requires four semesters in the same language for all majors except engineering and education. (However, engineering and education cadets may also take advantage of receiving bypass credits in foreign language). The Department of Modern Languages, Literatures and Cultures offers four languages in which you may fulfill the core requirement. If you wish to continue with the French, German, or Spanish you studied in high school, you must take The Citadel's **Foreign Language Placement Exam (FLPE)**. Your score will determine the level at which you will continue your foreign language study at The Citadel. The Chinese Placement Exam will be done on campus through an interview with a Chinese professor during the advising period.

**Part B: Mathematics Placement Process**

All students who elect to major in Biochemistry, Chemistry (B.S.), Civil Engineering, Computer Science, Electrical Engineering, Mathematics, Mechanical Engineering, or Physics are required to take a calculus sequence starting with MATH 131, Analytic Geometry and Calculus I. Other students may also elect to take MATH 131, for example, if they are considering the pursuit of a minor in Applied Mathematics or if they want to earn an American Chemical Society certificate as a Chemistry major. Our experience shows that many students entering college for the first time are not sufficiently prepared for the rigors of freshman calculus and require a semester of precalculus before attempting MATH 131. At The Citadel, our precalculus course is MATH 119, Precalculus. In order to help us determine the appropriate course for incoming freshmen, we have a placement process that is based primarily on the **Mathematics Placement Exam (MPE)**, which covers the basics of algebra and trigonometry. If you fall into any of the categories listed above, you are required to take a MPE online by 1 August.

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### **STEP 6 Summer School Reading Requirement**

In the fall of their freshman year, cadets are required to enroll in LDRS 101: First Year Experience which is designed to facilitate their transition to The Citadel. For this course, there is a summer reading assignment, and freshman students must purchase and read the book *A Few Good Men* by Aaron Sorkin prior to matriculation day. This reading assignment will provide opportunities for discussions about ethical concepts and issues during orientation and throughout the fall semester. Because this book is considered a textbook, The Citadel Bookstore has ordered the books for freshmen to purchase. - Students participating in the Citadel Success Institute(CSI) and registered for LDRS 101 must purchase and read the book prior to July 5.
