

FBI Special Agent Ann Colbert

Ann Colbert has been a Special Agent with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) for nearly 18 of her 28 years of Federal Government service. She has served in the FBI New Orleans Division working Public Corruption and White Collar Crime; the Washington Field Office in International and Domestic Terrorism and Weapons of Mass Destruction; was promoted to squad supervisor at the Washington Field Office; served as a supervisor in two components of FBI Headquarters; then was promoted back home to South Carolina as the Assistant Special Agent in Charge over all Criminal Programs, SWAT, Negotiators, and Admin in South Carolina. After four years in that role, she requested to step down to serve as the FBI's Recruiter in SC for her last two years until retirement and now recruits new Special Agents and Professional Staff throughout the state.

Ann holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Biology from Winthrop University and a Master of Science in Veterinary Medical Sciences from NC State University's College of Veterinary Medicine. Ann spent ten years in marine wildlife forensics and federal law enforcement with the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration prior to her FBI service.
