**COLLEGE FRESHMAN: REGISTER FOR OUR FRESHMEN AFROTC ACADEMIC CLASSES (FALL AERO 101 / SPRING AERO 102) AND LEADERSHIP LABORATORY (LLAB, AERO 450-01).**

**COLLEGE SOPHOMORE: REGISTER FOR OUR SOPHOMORE AFROTC ACADEMIC CLASSES (FALL AERO 201 / SPRING AERO 202) AND LEADERSHIP LABORATORY (AERO 450-03).**

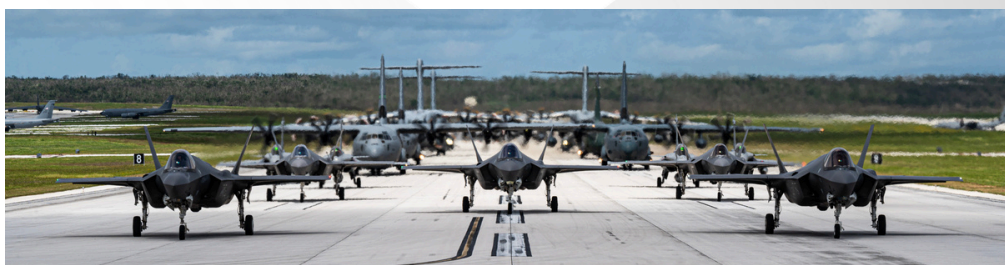
## NEW CADETS

**BRING THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS TO IN-PROCESSING:**

- **ORIGINAL STATE ISSUED BIRTH CERTIFICATE WITH RAISED SEAL OR US PASSPORT. IF BORN ABROAD PROOF OF US CITIZENSHIP IS REQUIRED. (ORIGINAL ONLY, WILL BE VERIFIED AND RETURNED)**
- **ORIGINAL SOCIAL SECURITY CARD. (ORIGINAL ONLY, WILL BE VERIFIED AND RETURNED)**
- **BOY SCOUTS, EAGLE SCOUT, GIRL SCOUT, OR CADET SENIOR SCOUT WITH GOLD PALM AWARD PAPERWORK (IF APPLICABLE, ORIGINAL ONLY, WILL BE COPIED AND RETURNED)**
- **CIVIL AIR PATROL AWARD–BILLY MITCHELL AWARD, AMELIA EARHART AWARD, CARL SPAATZ AWARD (IF APPLICABLE, ORIGINAL ONLY, WILL BE COPIED AND RETURNED)**
- **PRIVATE PILOT’S LICENSE (IF APPLICABLE, WILL BE COPIED AND RETURNED)**
- **JROTC CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION AND LETTER FROM JROTC COMMANDER (IF APPLICABLE, SHOULD CONTAIN AMOUNT OF TIME IN PROGRAM AND BE ON OFFICIAL JROTC LETTERHEAD SIGNED BY JROTC COMMANDER, WILL BE COPIED AND RETURNED)**
- **IF YOUR PARENTS/LEGAL GUARDIANS ARE CURRENT OR PRIOR MILITARY PLEASE BRING THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION: BRANCH, HIGHEST RANK HELD, AND TIME IN SERVICE.**
- **SELECTIVE SERVICE CARD (MALES ONLY – 18 YRS OR OLDER) OR REGISTRATION NUMBER.**
- **NAME AND ADDRESS OF ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICES THAT ISSUED YOU A TICKET OR FINED YOU AND THE DATES OF THE INCIDENT(S).**

**\* IF YOU ARE UNDER THE AGE OF 18 HAVE YOUR PARENT/GUARDIAN SIGN ENROLLMENT PAPERWORK ON MATRICULATION DAY OR DOWNLOAD THE ENROLLMENT FORMS AND HAVE THEM NOTARIZED.**

# PHYSICAL FITNESS ASSESSMENT (PFA)

THE PFA IS TAKEN TWICE A YEAR (FALL AND SPRING SEMESTERS) TO ENSURE CADETS MEET AIR FORCE FITNESS REQUIREMENTS.

CADETS WHO ARE IN THE GENERAL MILITARY COURSE (GMC) BUT NOT ON A SCHOLARSHIP MUST ATTEMPT THE TEST BUT DO NOT HAVE TO PASS.

CADETS ON A SCHOLARSHIP AND CADETS IN THE PROFESSIONAL OFFICER COURSE (POC) MUST PASS THE TEST EACH FALL AND SPRING TERM.

THE COMPONENTS OF THE PFA ARE CARDIORESPIRATORY FITNESS, MUSCULAR STRENGTH, AND CORE ENDURANCE.

- **CARDIORESPIRATORY FITNESS: 2.0 MILE RUN**
  - **MUSCULAR STRENGTH: 1-MINUTE PUSH-UPS**
  - **CORE ENDURANCE: 1-MINUTE SIT-UPS**
- \* **ACTIVE DUTY ALTERNATE COMPONENTS NOT AUTHORIZED FOR AFROTC**

THERE IS A REST PERIOD OF UP TO FIVE MINUTES IN BETWEEN EVENTS. YOU MUST EARN AT LEAST 75 POINTS OVERALL AND MEET THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS IN EACH COMPONENT.

# AIR FORCE OFFICER QUALIFICATION TEST (AFOQT)

THE AFOQT IS A STANDARDIZED TEST THAT MEASURES VERBAL AND MATHEMATICAL APTITUDE (SIMILAR TO THE SAT AND ACT) AS WELL AS ADDITIONAL APTITUDES RELEVANT TO SPECIFIC CAREER FIELDS.

IT IS ALSO USED TO QUALIFY FOR PILOT, COMBAT SYSTEMS OFFICER AND AIR BATTLE MANAGER TRAINING AND IS A COMPONENT OF THE PILOT CANDIDATE SELECTION METHOD (PCSM) SCORE.

## IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW:

- ALL CADETS MUST TAKE THE AFOQT BY THE END OF THEIR FIRST TERM IN AFROTC.
- ALL CADETS MUST PASS THE AFOQT BY THE END OF THEIR FALL TERM AS200 (SOPHOMORE) YEAR.
- CADETS WILL HAVE UP TO THREE OPPORTUNITIES TO PASS THE VERBAL AND QUANTITATIVE SECTIONS. (MINIMUMS: VERBAL-15, QUANTITATIVE-10)
- CADETS MAY RETEST NO EARLIER THAN 90 DAYS AFTER THE PREVIOUS ATTEMPT.
- SUPERSCORING WILL BE USED ACROSS ALL COMPOSITES. FOR SUPERSCORING, AN APPLICANT'S BEST COMPOSITE SCORE ON ANY TEST ATTEMPT WILL BE USED AS THE SCORE OF RECORD.

## EMAIL:

Your Citadel email address will be the primary means of communication. Cadets are required to check their email daily. We highly recommend every night to stay current on AFROTC events and information. Cadets are required to respond to emails in a timely manner (within 24 hours).

Whenever sending or replying to an email:

- Proofread your email. Proofread your email.
- Have a clear subject line.
- Use a professional greeting.
- Include your signature block.
- Keep it professional. No sarcasm or all caps.
- Don't ever assume the recipient knows what you are talking about.
- Be sure to reply to all emails in a timely manner (within 24 hours).

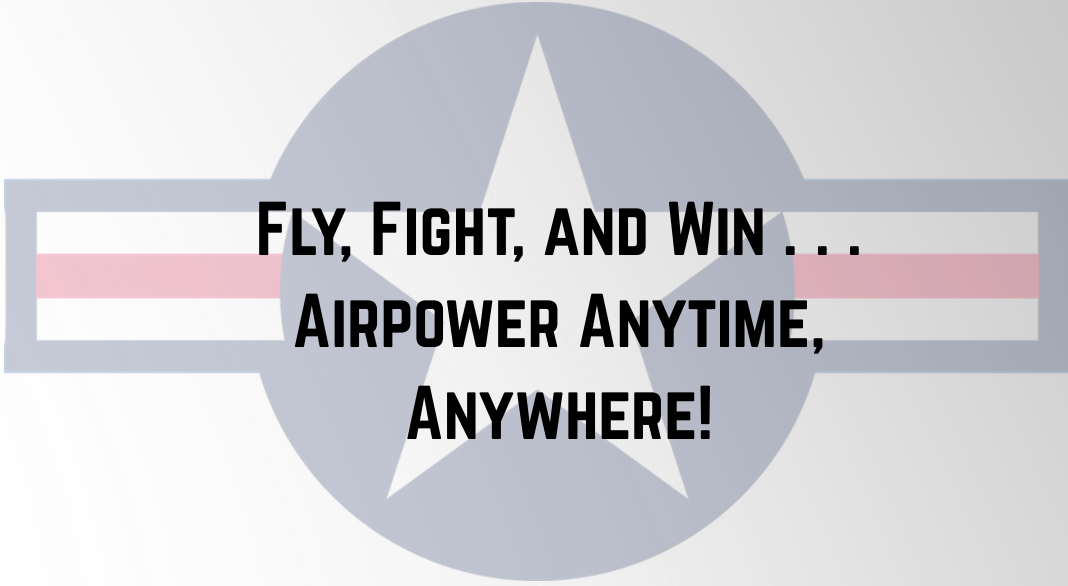

## PHONE:

Never underestimate the value of a phone call. Voice-to-voice communication allows for quicker resolution of issues, reduces the chance of miscommunication, and provides important context, tone, and emotion that are often lost in written messages. It also helps you strengthen your verbal communication skills—an essential trait for future officers. Your cell phone is another important means of communications for both the cadre and the cadet wing, so it is your responsibility to ensure your contact information is always current. Notify the Detachment immediately if your number changes. Additionally, always keep your phone on silent or vibrate during classes and official events to maintain professionalism and minimize disruptions.
