Quick Guide for Emergency Procedures

Active Shooter on Campus

- If possible, exit building; if exit is not possible, clear corridor and remain behind locked or barricaded door, close windows/blinds, turn off lights, stay out of view and remain quiet.
- Notify Public Safety.

Bomb Threat

- If threat comes by telephone, get as much information as possible.
- Notify Public Safety.

Fire

- Activate fire alarm.
- Notify Public Safety.
- Notify others in the building; help those needing assistance; evacuate the building.

Serious Injury/Accident

- Render immediate first aid and notify Public Safety.

Suspicious Package

- Do not touch package; evacuate immediate area.
- Notify Public Safety.

Suspicious Person

- Do not physically confront or block their exit from a building; do not let person into locked room.
- Notify Public Safety.

Tornado

- Seek refuge in an interior, ground floor hallway or room.
