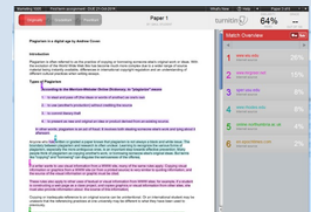
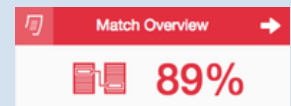

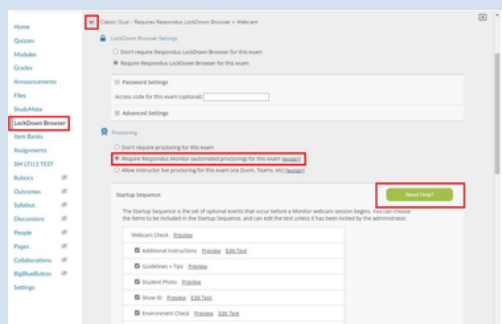


RESPONDUS LOCKDOWN BROWSER TIPS
