 - A. **Institutional Policies, Procedures, and Regulations.** College-level documents are available at <http://www.citadel.edu/root/policies-procedures>. The *College Regulations* are supreme to all Citadel doctrine.
 - B. **[South Carolina Corps of Cadets Catalog](#).** The South Carolina Corps of Cadets Catalog contains information about academic programs and policies.
 - C. **[Commandant and Regimental Memoranda and Operations Orders](#).** Commandant and Regimental Memoranda and Operations Orders are produced as necessary to provide guidance and instructions about specific policies and events.

- D. [Blue Book](#). The Regulations for the Corp of Cadets is more commonly called the Blue Book.
- E. [White Book](#). Organizations, Functions, and Standard Operating Procedures is more commonly called the White Book. In the case of a conflict, the Blue Book supersedes the White Book.
- F. [The Honor Manual](#). The Honor Manual describes the policies and procedures associated with The Citadel Honor Code and Honor System.
- G. [Citadel Training Model \(CTM\)](#). The CTM describes the five-step Citadel Training Model (expectations, skills, feedback, consequences, and growth).
- H. [Principled Leadership Skills \(PLS\)](#). Blocks of instruction on practical advice, techniques, tactics, and procedures for cadets in their development as Principled Leaders.
- I. [Guidon](#). The Guidon is published annually as a source of information for fourth-class cadets.
- J. [Citadel Physical Training Manual](#). The Citadel Physical Readiness Training manual parallels Army FM 7-22.
- K. [FM 22-Citadel](#). FM 22-Citadel is the drill and ceremony manual and is based on standard Army drill and ceremonies.
- L. [Regimental Guard Orders](#). The Regimental Guard Orders proscribe procedures for guards, posts, and guard mount.
- M. [Operations and Training webpage](#). The Operations and Training webpage houses materials associated with the Assistant Commandant for Operations and Training such as the annual training calendars and the weekly training schedules.
- N. [CC Forms](#). This page lists a number of forms used by cadets, the chain of command and the Commandant's Department in the execution of Corps of Cadets' daily business.
- O. [Cadet Accountability System \(CAS\)](#). CAS is the primary personnel and administrative management system for cadets.
