ELECTION DAY - 8 NOVEMBER 2022

- 1. No classes are scheduled on 8 November 2022 to allow the Corps of Cadets the opportunity to vote in various state and local elections.
- <u>Overnight Leave Policy</u>: Regardless of proficiency, all cadets, all classes, who do not have scheduled academic or military duties, will be authorized an overnight leave, from <u>after the last mandatory duty on</u> <u>Monday, 7 November until 1950 hours on 8 November, except C4/5 Cadets who return at 2230</u>. This will appear in CAS on 7 November as "*Election Day Overnight*".
- 3. <u>General Leave Policy</u>:
 - a. Monday, 7 November: General Leave for all cadets, regardless of proficiency, will begin after their last duty and terminate at 2400 hours (4C) and 0100 hours (UC).
 - b. Tuesday, 8 November: General Leave for all cadets, regardless of proficiency will begin at 0530 hours and terminate at 1950 hours, except for C4/5 Cadets who return at 2230 hours.
- 4. <u>Punishments</u>: No Punishments will be served. <u>Restrictions are suspended on 7 and 8 November</u>.
- 5. <u>Meals</u>: Dinner meal on 7 November and all meals on 8 November will be open mess for all classes. Open mess Brunch (Tuesday) will be served from 1000 hours to 1300 hours, open mess Dinner (Monday) will be served from 1800-1930 hours and Tuesday from 1800-1930.
- 6. <u>Absentee Voting</u>: For Cadets that live extensive distances from The Citadel check your State's rules about absentee voting. No leave beyond that referenced in paragraphs 2 and 3 above will be extended for the purpose of voting.
- 7. *Guard*: Guard/Duty teams remain in effect.
