

## The 20th President of The Citadel Glenn M. Walters

General, USMC (Retired)



General Glenn M. Walters, United States Marine Corps, Class of 1979, returned to his alma mater in the fall of 2018 after serving 39 years as an officer in the Marines. Prior to his arrival, he served as the 34th Assistant Commandant of the Marine Corps, the Corps' second-highest ranking officer.

Upon graduating from The Citadel with a Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering, General Walters received his commission, initially serving as an infantry officer. He attended flight training in Pensacola, Florida and was designated a naval aviator in 1981. Walters later trained and served as a test pilot and was instrumental in testing systems for the AH-1W Super Cobra Attack Helicopter. He also served as the first Commander of VMX-22, the initial squadron to field the MV-22 Osprey tiltrotor aircraft for operational testing. He deployed overseas on numerous occasions in the Pacific and Central Command theaters, including Korea, the Arabian Gulf and Afghanistan.

General Walters additionally served in numerous leadership and staff positions in the Marines and on the Joint Staff. Other command tours included Marine Helicopter Training Squadron 303 and the Second Marine Aircraft Wing, which General Walters commanded in Afghanistan.

Walters' military awards include the Distinguished Service Medal, the Defense Superior Service Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster, the Legion of Merit with Oak Leaf Cluster, the Meritorious Service Medal with Star, the Air Medal, and numerous campaign and unit awards.

In April 2018, Walters was selected by The Citadel's Board of Visitors as the 20th President of the college. General Walters is joined by his wife Gail. A marketing and communications professional, she eagerly embraces her role as The Citadel's First Lady.

# IN HONOR & MEMORY OF LT GEN CLAUDIUS "BUD" WATTS III, '58 THE 17TH PRESIDENT OF THE CITADEL 1936-2023



Claudius "Bud" Watts was a native of Cheraw, South Carolina, who led with distinction in the military, academia, finance, and public service.

Attending The Citadel on a full academic scholarship, Lieutenant General Watts distinguished himself in the classroom, as Chairman of the Cadet Honor Committee, and as an ROTC cadet. After graduation in 1958, he attended the London School of Economics and Political Science as a Fullbright Scholar.

As an Air Force Officer, Lieutenant General Watts amassed 7,000 flight hours as a Command Pilot. This included 276 missions in Vietnam, where he was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross three times, among other gallantry and combat awards.

Lieutenant General Watts held leadership positions of increasing importance throughout his Air Force career. He commanded flying units at multiple levels, including an Airlift Group in New Jersey, and an Airlift Wing in California.

Other advanced assignments included a tour as the Director of the Air Force Budget at the Pentagon, Senior Military Assistant to the Deputy Secretary of Defense, with his final post of thirty-one years' uniformed service coming as Comptroller of the Air Force. Concurrently, he served as Chairman of the Board for the Army and Air Force Exchange Service, one of the largest retail businesses in the United States.

Lieutenant General Watts' decorations include 44 awards for both combat and peacetime achievement, to include The United States' highest non-combat award, the Defense Distinguished Service medal. He further earned an MBA from the Stanford Graduate School of Business, degrees from the Army Command and General Staff College, the National War College, and completed the Program for Senior Managers in Government from Harvard.

In 1989, Lieutenant General Watts retired from the Air Force and was named the 17th President of The Citadel, his Alma Mater. His leadership was immediately tested with Hurricane Hugo, which severely damaged key structures across campus, and forced the college to close for over three weeks. His seven year tenure was marked by improvements in programs and facilities, a once in a decade overall academic reaccreditation, and recertification of individual areas of scholarship.

He also served on the NCAA Council, the governing body for college athletics, several associated committees, and the Stanford Graduate School of Business Advisory Board.

After leaving The Citadel in 1996, Lieutenant General Watts pursued a third career in banking with the Carolina Financial Corporation, where he served as a Founding Director and ultimately Chairman of the Board of Directors. As Chair, he successfully navigated the 2008-2009 financial crisis and subsequently oversaw the Corporation's aggressive growth and debut as a public company.





# IN HONOR & MEMORY OF COL Stanley L. Myers, Sr., '98 BOARD OF VISITORS MEMBER 2014-2023 1976-2023

COL Stanley L. Myers, Sr. graduated from the South Carolina Corps of Cadets with a degree in Political Science. He returned to his alma mater in 2014 to serve on the Board of Visitors and was reelected for another term in 2020. His leadership, insight, and commitment to our institution has been immense.

He was always humble and represented his alma mater and community with the utmost respect and pride. He was a great man and a steadfast servant leader. A native of Swansea, SC, COL Myers contributed in countless ways to The Citadel and the State of South Carolina. A lawyer and Lieutenant Colonel in the South Carolina National Guard, he distinguished himself in his professional career, becoming the first African American military judge in South Carolina history; and in 2022 was inducted into the American College of Trial Lawyers, a preeminent and nationally recognized organization of lawyers.

During his time in the Corps of Cadets, Stanley wore the number 16 for the Bulldogs. He completed his athletic career at The Citadel starting 43 out of 44 games as quarterback. He is the only player in Citadel history to ever throw for 3,000-plus yards and to rush for 2,000-plus yards.
