

Measure 3 – Advanced Programs Candidate competency at completion.

Data provided demonstrate the EPP is meeting program expectations and preparing candidates to be recommended for licensure. The M.Ed. in Educational Leadership program which prepares candidates as school principals and supervisors either at the elementary or secondary school level. The data below displays pass rates for the required licensure exam, Praxis 5412 Ed Leadership: Administration and Supervision. The required minimum passing score is 146.

Analysis of Data: In academic year 2023-2024, a total of 38 program completers in the M.Ed. Educational Leadership program took the Praxis licensure exam. For this academic year, all but 2 completers passed the exam on their first attempt for a pass rate of 95%. The two completers that were unsuccessful on their first attempt passed on their second attempt. As such, the data are indicative that 95% of the program completers were well-prepared to pass the licensure exam on their first attempt and the remaining 5% on their second attempt, thereby meeting the requirement for certification.

As of academic year 2023-2024, the South Carolina Department of Education adopted an exam specific for superintendent certification. The new exam, Praxis 6991 School Superintendent Assessment requires a minimum passing score of 162.

Analysis of Data: In academic year 2023-2024, a total of 2 program completers in the Ed.S. Educational Leadership program took the Praxis licensure exam in order to receive superintendent certification. Both completers were successful in passing the exam for a 100% pass rate for the academic year.
