

## Measure 3 (Initial): Candidate competency at completion.

Data provided demonstrate the EPP is meeting program expectations and preparing candidates to be ready to be recommended for licensure.

Twenty-three candidates took the Praxis content exams in the areas of Biology, Mathematics, Physical Education, and Social Studies. These candidates are now being evaluated under SC Department of Education's 3-year pilot program, whereby they reduced the achievement score requirements of content area Praxis exams needed to earn certification. This year's data reflects a nuanced picture as some candidates who under ordinary conditions would have repeated the test to officially pass it, now have limited reasons to do so with the reduction of the test score requirement for certification. As a result, we have a higher percentage of candidates completing the program with certification, but a lower overall percentage of candidates technically passing the test at the traditional level set by the state.

The survey results depict an EPP created program completer survey to enable the reflection on one's satisfaction with their teacher preparation program at The Citadel. Results indicate that completers are satisfied or very satisfied with the majority of areas in which they were prepared with mean scores of 3.50. However, with mean scores of 3.25, it appears that additional emphasis on the use of technology, opportunities for professional growth and development, as well as short and long-range planning should be considered.
