

# Measure 4 – Advanced Programs Ability of completers to be hired in positions for which they have prepared.

Employment data shows the following:

## M.Ed. in Literacy Education (n=6)

• Four of six program completers in literacy education hold positions using their knowledge and skills in literacy, including one that serves as a literacy assistant.

# M.Ed. in Educational Leadership (n=8)

- Two program completers have obtained positions as assistant principals.
- Of the six remaining, one serves as an instructional coach, two serve as math coaches, one is a lead teacher, and one serves as an interventionist.

#### **Ed.S.** in **Educational Leadership** (n=6)

- One program completer serves as a district director.
- Of the remaining five, three serve as assistant principals, one as a teacher coordinator, and one as a special education educator.

## M.Ed. in Counselor Education (n=6)

• Five of six program completers hold school counselor positions. The other program completer works for the South Carolina Department of Education.
