The **Helen Zabawa Pinarchick and Joseph John Pinarchick Scholarship** gives first preference to an exemplary, well-rounded **junior** or **senior** undergraduate cadet in good standing who meets the cadet physical fitness requirements.

Please read all eligibility requirements before applying:

- Financial need (2025-26 FAFSA on file),
- Must be a junior or senior,
- Must meet PT requirements,
- Out-of-state resident,
- GPA of 2.85 or better,
- A U.S. born or naturalized citizen,
- Must be an active member of a cadet club or charitable activity on or off campus,
- Must **NOT** have more than \$7,000 in scholarships already awarded,
- Must **NOT** have an athletic scholarship in a major sport.
