
IN-STATE/OUT-OF-STATE RESIDENCY STATUS

Percent of SCCC









GEOGRAPHICAL ORIGIN BY STATE FOR CADETS









Percent of Active Duty






ENROLLMENT BY MAJOR - EVENING UNDERGRADUATES




