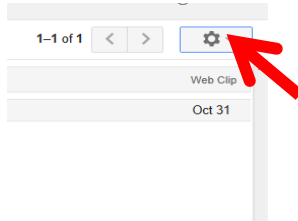
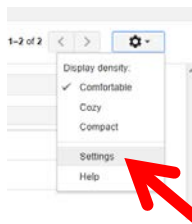


## Linking Email Accounts Through WebMail

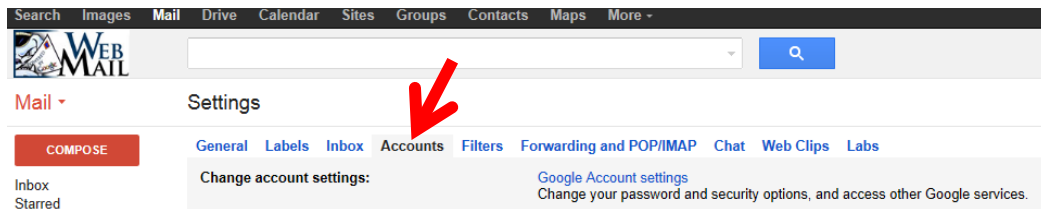
1. Log into your Citadel Gmail account
2. Click on the settings button in upper, right-hand corner



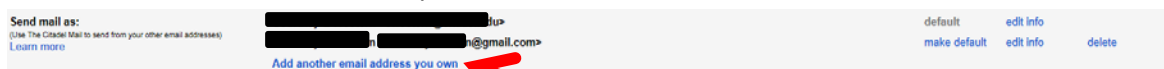
3. Select "Settings"
