MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

Subj: COVID-19 Guidance to the SCCC Fall 22

Cadets: As we matriculate the class of 2026 and reconstitute the Corps for AY 22-23, the following COVID protocols will be followed:

- Only symptomatic cadets will be tested.
- Positive cadets will be in isolation/quarantine for 5-days (day 0 is the first day of symptoms or day of positive viral test).
 - The infirmary team will notify SgtMaj Yagle of positive case
 - The infirmary will evaluate patients in isolation and provide medications as required.
 - Ending isolation: Cadets will be released from isolation after 5-full days provided they are fever free for 24-hours with improving symptoms. No testing required. Cadets will be required to wear a mask for an additional 5-days.
- Cadets will be discharged from quarantine with no restrictions. Those still feeling unwell will be reassessed at the clinic.
- No testing for asymptomatic exposures or roommates
- No contact tracing
- No isolation of close contacts

Cadets are encouraged to ensure all of their vaccinations are up to date. The COVID vaccine, boosters, and the flu shot will be offered on campus this fall. Finally, if you are feeling ill, please report to the clinic at the Infirmary.
