

Memorandum

ELECTION DAY – 6 NOVEMBER 2018

1. No classes are scheduled on 6 November 2018 to allow the Corps of Cadets the opportunity to vote in various national and local elections.
2. Overnight Leave Policy: Regardless of proficiency, all cadets, all classes, who do not have scheduled academic or military duties, will be authorized an overnight leave, from after the last mandatory duty on Monday, 5 November until 1950 hours on 6 November, except 1st Class Cadets who return at 2230.
3. General Leave Policy:
 - a. Monday, 5 November: General Leave for all cadets, regardless of proficiency, will begin after their last duty and terminate at 2400 hours (4C) and 0100 hours (UC).
 - b. Tuesday, 6 November: General Leave for all cadets, regardless of proficiency will begin at 0530 hours and terminate at 1950 hours, except for 1st Class Cadets who return at 2230 hours.
4. Punishments: No Punishments will be served. Restrictions are suspended on 5 and 6 November.
5. Meals: Dinner meal on 5 November and all meals on 6 November will be open mess for all classes. Open mess Brunch (Tuesday) will be served from 1000 hours to 1300 hours, open mess Dinner (Monday) will be served from 1800-1930 hours and Tuesday from 1800-1930.
6. Absentee Voting: For Cadets that live extensive distances from The Citadel check your State's rules about absentee voting. No leave beyond that referenced in paragraphs 2 and 3 above will be extended for the purpose of voting.
7. Guard: Guard/Duty teams remain in effect.
