The **Helen Zabawa Pinarchick and Joseph John Pinarchick Scholarship** gives first preference to an exemplary, well-rounded **junior** or **senior** undergraduate cadet in good standing who meets the cadet physical fitness requirements.

Additional eligibility requirements are:

- Financial need (2020-21 FAFSA on file);
- Must be a junior or senior
- Must meet PT requirements
- Out-of-state resident;
- GPA of 2.85 or better;
- A U.S. born or naturalized citizen;
- Must not have more than \$7,000 in scholarships already awarded;
- Must be an active member of a cadet club or charitable activity on or off campus;
- Must not have an athletic scholarship in a major sport.
