The Harry S. Dent Scholarship Committee is pleased to open competition for the Harry S. Dent Scholarship. Applicants for the award must submit an essay of at least 3,000 words (exclusive of notes and bibliography) in one of the following topic areas:

- the comparative advantages of the American political and economic systems;
- the new challenges facing America from terrorism;
- some other aspect of history, literature, government, law, international relations, or politics central to understanding the American experience.

Applicants must have a cumulative GPR of at least a 3.0 in all classes taken at The Citadel.

Papers will be evaluated based upon grammar, a well-argued thesis, and original research in primary materials. Applicants may submit a paper they have written to fulfill a course requirement.

The deadline for submission of essays is *March 26, 2021* no later than 1600 hours. Applicants may submit only one paper.

A faculty committee will evaluate the submitted essays. All submissions, and any requests for further information, must be addressed to Professor Kyle S. Sinisi (sinisik@citadel.edu), Department of History. All submissions must be by electronic attachment (MS Word) in email.

In addition to the attached paper, the body of your email must contain your full name, CWID, cumulative GPR, and a listing of the general topic area your paper addresses. General topic areas are listed below the first paragraph of this announcement.
